## *Services & Amenities*

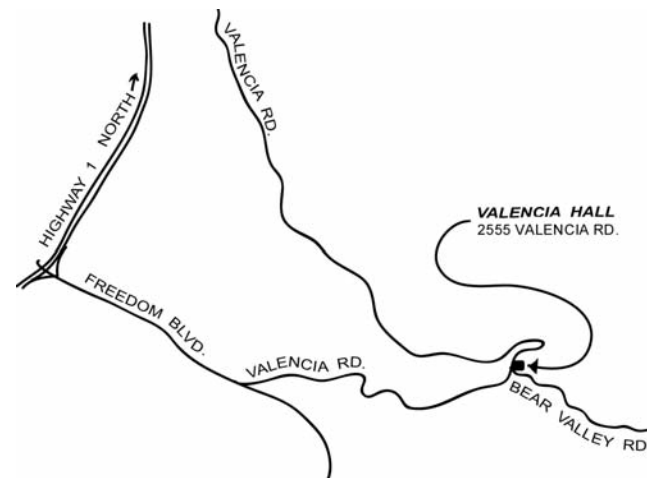
- Catering - Arrange for a caterer of your choice or provide your own food service.
- Kitchen Facilities - Moderately equipped. Bring your own supplies.
- Set up and clean up is the responsibility of the reserving group, and must be done within the hours of your reservation.
- Tables and Chairs - 60 chairs and 14 six-foot banquet tables are provided. Bring your own linens and other supplies.
- Alcohol Permit - 3-5 hours of alcohol service. Beer, wine and champagne only. Permit requires alcohol service fee and a deposit.
- Sound Permit - 3-5 hours of indoor amplified music.
- Wheelchair Accessibility - Fully accessible.
- Parking - Large lot.

## *Reservation Information*

- Reservations can be made up to one year in advance of the desired date.
- All fees are due and payable at the time the reservation is made.
- Weekend rentals are for a minimum of 6 hours, to include at least one hour set-up and clean-up; flexibility to add hours at hourly rental rate, up to a 5-hour maximum event time. 2-hour clean-up required for reservations with 10 or more hours.
- Hourly rentals are available on weekdays and during winter months.

The Valencia Hall and General Store/Post Office are all that remain of the once thriving community of Valencia. Built in the 1880s by Frederick A. Hihn for his Valencia logging mill workers and their families, Valencia Hall originally served as a community meeting place for dances, Sunday school, the Lyceum and Literary Society, and in later years, for a variety of other community events.

Located just five minutes from Highway 1 in the Aptos hills, Valencia Hall offers a private, affordable place to hold your special event.
