Title 22 Certification

This course provides participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to meet the first aid requirements for lifeguards, firefighters and peace officers as defined in Title 22 of the California Code of Regulations.

Please Note: the information covered in this course is included in the Lifeguard Training Courses offered at Simpkins Swim Center

Course Prerequisites

Course participants must have either a current Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED certificate, a CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuers and Health Care Providers certification, or equivalent.

Materials are included in the fee and will be distributed upon registration.

Important Reminders

Please keep in mind that participation in the entire class session and completion of reading assignment before each the class is required to pass the Title 22 course. Upon successful completion of this course you will receive a Title 22 (Advanced First Aid) certification which is valid for 3 years.
