**Rental Information:**

Reservations are required for organized groups and for guaranteed use of fields. Groups are responsible for set-up, clean-up, lining, and nets for soccer goals.

**Rental Fees:**

Youth hourly rates:\$21.35 Residents; \$23.50 Non-Residents.  
Adult hourly rates: \$26.70 Residents;\$29.35 Non-Residents.

25% Non-Profit discount. Continuous user and league discounts available.

**Contract Requirements:**

- ✓ Completion of facility use contract and payment.
- ✓ Read and sign Athletic Field Rules and Regulations.
- ✓ \$50 damage deposit required per field.
- ✓ Provision of \$1,000,000 per occurrence general liability insurance as required by the Department holding the County additionally insured and the named certificate holder. Insurance is required prior to field use.

**Hours:**

8-hour minimum per day on weekends; 2-hour minimum per day on weekdays or within three weeks of a weekend date. Hours and field availability vary per season and park.

Fields are open mid-March through mid-November. A fine is charged for play on closed fields.
