## Inflatable Jump House Rules

**Permit:** Jump houses are allowed at County Parks and require a \$50 fee, with or without a picnic reservation. Permits may be obtained at the Parks Department's Facilities office.

**Reservations:** Reservations may be made daily between 10:00 AM – Dusk. Reservations are made on a first come, first served basis and can be made up to one year in advance. Minors are not eligible to reserve facilities. Full payment is required when the reservation is made.

**Parks:** Inflatable jump houses are allowed at the following parks: Anna Jean Cummings Park picnic area A, Aptos Park, Brommer Street Park picnic area, Highlands Park picnic areas, Felton Covered Bridge Park, Pinto Lake County Park picnic areas, Polo Grounds, and Scott Park. No more than one jump house may be set up per park per day. Set up conditions may vary per park. Please see your contract for special conditions. Deputy sheriffs monitor the parks. If a jump house is set up without a permit or in violation of the regulations, the vendor may be asked to remove it.

**Insurance:** One million dollars per occurrence general liability insurance, holding the County as additionally insured, is required. A certificate of insurance must be provided by the permittee or jump house vendor and filed with the Facilities office before the event.

**Electricity and Generators:** Electricity is available at only Pinto Lake County Park group picnic areas only and at picnic area A at Anna Jean Cummings Park. A sound permit, limited to five hours, is required when a generator is used. If generators need to be refilled, please do so on pavement only.

**Vehicles:** Vehicles are allowed in designated parking areas only; driving on grass areas or outside of parking areas is prohibited.

**Cancellations:** Reservations may be cancelled in person or in writing not less than 14 days prior to the scheduled event, with a permit processing fee of \$100.00 or 50% of the permit fee, whichever is less. Cancellations of less than 14 days receive No refund of fees.

**Damage:** Permittee will be liable for damage done during events that is not covered by a deposit. Staff rates to repair the facility are charged at current maintenance staff hourly rate. Bills unpaid after 30 days are sent to collections.

**No Overnight Storage:** Permittee may bring rental equipment, but must arrange for it to be delivered and removed the same day as your reservation.

**Alcohol:** Alcohol consumption is not permitted in the County Parks outdoor facilities.

**Sound Permit:** No amplified sound is permitted at Anna Jean Cummings, Brommer and Highlands Parks reservable picnic areas.

**Set-up and Clean-up:** Permittee is responsible for general set-up and clean up of the premises. Please leave facilities and grounds free of debris and other refuse. The facility must be restored to pre-use conditions.

**Activities for Minors:** Groups, which are comprised predominately of participants under 21 years of age, must be chaperoned at a minimum ratio of one adult (over 21 years) to 12 minors.

**Checks:** Checks returned for insufficient funds, and chargebacks, are charged at the current processing fee. Please note that credit cards are charged from Santa Cruz County.

**Changes to the Permit:** Any changes to the permit must be made in writing by the Permittee only. No changes will be made with less than three days notice. Date changes are subject to a \$50. change of date fee and Department approval, and must be made with at least fourteen days advance written notice.

**Sub-Lease:** Permittee shall not assign or sub-lease any portion of the premises, or any rights under approved permit, without prior written approval of the Department.

**Lost Items:** The Parks Department is not responsible for items left.

**Concessions:** The County reserves sole right to control and limit all concessions in and about department buildings and park facilities through separate agreements.
