Abundance-Scarcity Codes

- 0 = Irruptive: Present only in certain years
1 = Common: Almost always seen in proper habitat
2 = Fairly Common: Often seen or heard
3 = Uncommon: Sometimes seen or heard
4 = Rare: Annual and predictable, but still irregular
5 = Casual: Occurrence every few years (or less)
6 = Accidental: Very few records, usually less than three

Seasonal Codes

- AY= Present at Quail Hollow all year
W = Present in Winter
Sp = Present in Spring
Su = Present in Summer
F = Present in Fall

Breeding Codes

- B = Breeding confirmed at Quail Hollow
L = Breeding likely, but not confirmed
F = Former breeder
