2022 New Recreation and Cultural Opportunities County of Santa Cruz Parks Grant Program - Guidelines



Each fiscal year, County of Santa Cruz allocates funds for community partners to provide cultural and recreational services. Starting in 2022-23, a portion of these funds will provide for a small grant to reach communities that historically County Parks was not able to reach and serve.

County Parks Mission Statement

The County of Santa Cruz Department of Parks, Open Space and Cultural Services mission is to provide safe, well-designed and maintained parks, and a wide variety of recreational and cultural opportunities for our diverse community.

County Parks Vision Statement

We envision a healthy and vibrant county where everyone is able to be active, explore, learn, play and connect, and where our diverse natural and cultural resources are celebrated and protected for generations to come.

Strategic and Operational Plan

Eligible Recipients

To be an eligible recipient, the organization needs to be located within County of Santa Cruz, and registered or be willing to register as a Vendor with the County.

Eligible Projects

The proposed program should fulfill County Parks' Mission and Vision statements, align with County Parks' Strategic Plan, and serve areas within the unincorporated part of the County of Santa Cruz.

Selection

As part of the effort, County Parks developed project selection criteria that incorporates:

- Need for the program
- Benefit to communities underserved by County Parks
- Community engagement
- Volunteer opportunities
- Prior partnerships

Application Deadline

Proposals are due by 5pm on **July 15, 2022**, for programs that take place in the 2022-23 fiscal year. If funding allows, proposals submitted after this date will continue to be considered on a rolling basis after the first batch of submissions is reviewed.

Funding and Timeline

Funding for this grant program is available in Cultural Services budget. The recommended requested amount is \$5,000, but actual awards might differ from requested amounts based on available funding and number of applications.

Awards are expected to be announced in August 2022.

The project shall take place and funds shall be spent within fiscal year it was awarded.

Funds disbursement and Reporting requirements

If awarded, County Parks will provide funds in two installment payments, forty percent (40%) within thirty (30) days of receiving a Payment Request #1 after proposal is approved and the contract is fully executed, and the remaining sixty percent (60%) upon the acceptance of a Final Project Report and Payment Request #2.

Funds should be used solely for the designated purposes as described in the executed Agreement and subject to Grantee's performance of all requirements under the Agreement.

Final Program Report shall include the following materials: documentation of activities offered (e.g., activity calendar, program flyers, photographs, etc.) and attendance figures. In addition, recipient shall acknowledge in all reports and literature, as well as on the agency website, that the County of Santa Cruz has provided funding for proposed program.
